

## OPEN ENROLLMENT POLICY

### **Cory-Rawson Local Schools for 2016-2017**

#### Interdistrict Open Enrollment

In compliance with ORC 3313.98, the Cory-Rawson Board of Education shall permit enrollment of students who are residents of school districts that are adjacent to the boundaries of the Cory-Rawson School District or any “other district” (as defined in O.R.C. 3313.98) with respect to grade level capacities, building capacities, and program capacities as established by the Cory-Rawson Board of Education.

The aforementioned capacities will be established annually by the Board of Education based upon the recommendation of the superintendent.

Board-adopted capacities will be made available to school district building administrators for their use in enrolling students who are residents of school districts, which are adjacent to the boundaries of the Cory-Rawson School District or any “other district”. However, no student will be admitted under this Open Enrollment Policy without approval of the superintendent.

#### Athletic Releases

The Cory-Rawson Board of Education will grant athletic releases as required by OHSAA Bylaws to all resident students who participate in the open enrollment programs of other districts.

#### Bus Transportation

In compliance with ORC 3313.98, the Cory-Rawson School District will not be required to alter established school bus routes within the Cory-Rawson School District in order to accommodate open enrollment students. The student or his family may provide transportation to an established bus stop within the Cory-Rawson School District for the purpose of the student being transported to school.

#### Graduation Credits

The Cory-Rawson Board of Education will accept all credits toward graduation from enrolled students who are residents of school districts, which are adjacent to the boundaries of the Cory-Rawson School District, or any “other district” in Ohio.

#### Provision of Information

In compliance with ORC 3313.98, the Cory-Rawson Board of Education will provide information regarding open enrollment policies and regulations to the superintendents and boards of education of adjacent school districts and, upon request, to “other districts” and individual parents. Superintendents will be notified if a resident student of their district is accepted into the Cory-Rawson Schools under the provisions of this policy.

#### Special Education Services

Pursuant to ORC 3313.98, the Cory-Rawson Board of Education will deny the enrollment of a special education student who is a resident of a school district which is adjacent to the boundaries of the Cory-Rawson School District or any “other district”, and who requires services that are not available in the Cory-Rawson School District. Students requiring special education services, which are offered in the Cory-Rawson School District, will be obligated to attend the school building where the services specified in the student's IEP are available.

#### Non-Discrimination

In compliance with ORC 3313.98, the Cory-Rawson Board of Education will enroll students without differentiation on the basis of academic, athletic, artistic, or extra-curricular activity, or proficiency in English. No person shall, on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, sex, or disability be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program.

This policy shall be reviewed annually by the Board to determine whether to adopt a resolution to continue the policy, or to rescind interdistrict open enrollment. The Board reserves the right to modify the conditions under which interdistrict open enrollment would continue for any particular program, classroom, or school.
