Hello:

As predicted Governor DeWine offered additional guidance related to graduation ceremonies for the Class of 2020 during his daily press conference today. An article related to his statement can be found below. To briefly summarize, the governor offered the following:

- ▶ "Mass gatherings simply cannot be held." (Governor DeWine Press Conference, April 29, 2020)
- ▶ The preferred ceremony is a virtual graduation as many schools are already doing.
- ▶ A second recommendation includes drive-in ceremonies where students drive to a designated location at a specific time to get their diplomas.
- ▶ A third would be an event with 10 people or less at a time, with social distancing, where a graduate can receive their diploma.

- ▶ "Each school district must work with their local health department to make sure that their plan is in accordance with public health guidelines to deal with the pandemic." (Governor DeWine Press Conference, April 29, 2020)

Additional information will be shared in coming days. The preliminary plan shared via Community Update is available below for additional review. Feedback continues to be gathered from students in the senior class, their parents, and other stakeholders as well.
