DLT Update

Our District Leadership Team has continued to make good progress on our district goals despite all the demands on their time with testing, delays, cancellations, and the seemingly constant revisions to lesson plans and evaluation schedules that our staff faces. A subcommittee has been nominated to further examine the core attributes that we desire in any future curriculum investments. Their work will immediately and directly impact a primary goal of the DLT which is to pursue a more unified and aligned math curriculum for the K-6 and 7-12 levels. While there are myriad things which impact student learning, one of the most significant pieces is the building block that a strong curriculum represents. A strong curriculum, though, is only as effective as those who are implementing it. To that end, we continue to focus on ensuring we are using research-based best practices for teaching methods in the classroom (another DLT goal).

Calendar Revision

Due to the chaotic schedule through the first part of the calendar year we have postponed the previously scheduled In-service day on Friday, March 20th.
