

Additionally, employees who serve on the district administrative team will be part of the committee as well.

Committee members will convene several times in the next week or two in an effort to draft a comprehensive plan to promote a healthy, safe school year. These recommendations will be presented to the Cory-Rawson Board of Education at the July 28th Board of Education meeting and will be reviewed by Hancock Public Health as well. The district will have a comprehensive plan established by no later than August 1, 2020.

Various school districts throughout the state of Ohio have released "tentative" information and/or plans recently. For instance, two Hancock County Schools, Arlington and McComb, disseminated letters to their respective communities yesterday. These letters can be found below for informational purposes. As the superintendent of our district, the broad intentions discussed in these letters align with many of my personal feelings; however, to formally communicate such (at this time) as the intent of our district would be discourteous to the upcoming work of the Healthy Restart Committee. As mentioned previously, the methodical, thoughtful course of our district is in an effort to create a healthy, safe educational environment for the students, staff, and community members of the Cory-Rawson Local School District.
